## Starting Up A Drupal 11 Site

### To Create a Site


1. Head over to <https://drupalforge.org>
2. Click on **Demo Drupal 11 Launch button**
3. Answer the math question and click **Express Launch**.
4. When the site is ready, click on **Login URL**. Your username and password is **devpanel**.
5. The site will launch and you can log in.



### Saving the environment and lengthening the time remaining

1. Return to the main page with **your information** on it.
2. **Click Save.**
3. The **easiest and by-far best option** is to log in with a Google account - either a personal or business account. Signing up with an email/password combination takes much longer and the emails will likely end up in your spam folder.
4. Once you log in, you'll be returned to the main page.
5. Click on the LAUNCH button for Drupal 11 Demo again and **click Save AGAIN**. This adds the site to your account. (They're working on making this far easier).
6. You can see all your sites by clicking on the MyApp button at the top right.

7. On the right hand side, click on **Actions**, then **Workspace**. You'll end up at a screen that looks like this:



There is a **ton of information** on this page.

**You only need to use the information at the five numbers:**

1. This is to pause and unpause your application. Since you're logged in, you can keep this for 30 days but it pauses when the clock (in #3) runs out.
2. This is the link to your application. The username and password is "devpanel".
3. This is the application timer. Clicking on it will give you extra time, up to 12 hours total per day. Click enough times to ensure uninterrupted site building during training.
4. Click the copy button to copy the password for the development environment.
5. Click to launch VSCode in a browser for Composer and Drush access.
